Apprenticeship participants are invoiced for all apprenticeship fees and are responsible for payment of those fees, regardless whether they pay them personally, the contractor pays them, or a combination. Payment terms are Net 30 days. Apprentices will not be allowed to continue in class without paid up tuition by the "drop/add" date set by Pima Community College.
